

***Technical Rider***  
***Glen Rose Show***

***LOCAL PRESENTER AGREES TO FURNISH AT OWN EXPENSE:***

**STAGE REQUIREMENTS:** Standard concert set-up. Stage should be swept clean and cleared of all equipment, debris, etc., prior to Artists' arrival.

**PIANO REQUIREMENTS:** One in tune grand piano — 6 to 7 feet preferable, but any size will do.

**SOUND REQUIREMENTS:**

2 microphones for singing

2 boom mic stands

a. One at the left side of the piano bench for singing

b. One in the middle of the stage for speaking and playing ukulele

2 stage monitors ( only vocals and guitar in monitors). Absolutely no piano in monitors piano please)

a. One on the left side of the piano bench

b. One positioned stage left, down stage

One direct box for amplified classical guitar (Glen Rose provides guitar)

**LIGHTING REQUIREMENTS:** Good overhead concert lighting is required.

Glen Rose brings 4 gobos that are preferable projected on a backdrop screen filling up as much of the screen as possible, creating a pleasing backdrop.

Lighting can be simply a few standard color gels (amber, blue, gold, etc) to create soft stage lighting that can be altered from song to song at the lighting techs creative discretion.

NOTE: If no lighting or gobo projection is available it s OK. The show runs nicely with house light turned up full. Lighting adds to the show but is not critical to it.

**OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** 1 hat rack (positioned to the left of the piano bench.

**SOUND CHECK REQUIREMENTS:** Sound check should be completed early enough to allow at least an hour of rest time before show time. Artist will contact presenter no later than 24 hours before arrival to schedule sound check.

**DRESSING ROOM REQUIREMENTS:** A dressing room is nice, but not necessary. At least two bottles of spring water and a cup of coffee would be appreciated.

**RECORDINGS:** If possible, one volunteer to sell Artists' recordings before the concert, at intermission, and after the concert.
